

The bill from the senate, entitled, A further supplement to an act, entitled, An act to establish a Bank and incorporate a company under the name of "The Cumberland Bank of Allegany," was taken up for consideration, and read the second time.

When on motion by Mr. Handy, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Peregoy, the bill from the senate entitled, An act to close certain streets on the land of James Carroll, in the city of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

On motion by Mr. Heard, the bill from the senate, entitled, An act for the benefit of Andrew Hook of the city of Baltimore, was taken up for consideration, read the second time by special order and passed.

The clerk of the senate returned the bill, entitled, An act for the relief of John Gauer, endorsed, "will pass;" ordered to be engrossed;

And, the resolution allowing Samuel Pool to compound on his certificate of survey, endorsed, "assented to with the proposed amendment;"

Which amendment was read the first and second time by special order, and "assented to;" ordered to be engrossed;

And, delivered a letter from John S. Martin, Esq., accepting his appointment as a member of the Executive Council, endorsed referred to the consideration of the House of Delegates;

Which was read.
