And Mr. Hurtt reported a bill, entitled, an act relating to division fences between different proprietors in Kent county;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Jones of Baltimore city reported a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Fire Company of Baltimore.

Which was read the first time and referred to the committee on corporations.

Mr. Franklin Smith reported a bill, entitled, a further supplement to the act passed at December session, 1816, chapter 199, regulating the cording of firewood in the city of Baltimore;

Which was read the first and second time by special order;

When on motion by Mr. Nicols, the said bill was ordered to lie on the table and be printed.

The bill reported by Mr. Peregoy, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Mechanics' Saving Fund Society of Baltimore, was read the second time and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Peregoy, entitled an act to incorporate the Baltimore Saving's institution, was taken up for consideration.

On motion by Mr. Nicols, the blank in the 10th section of the bill was filled up with the year eighteen hundred and forty five.

The said bill was then read a second time and passed.

On motion by Mr Ely, the house took up for consideration the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore Lyceum.

The question being on the adoption of the amendment proposed by Mr. Scott to said bill.

Determined in the negative.
