

Mr. Brengle, from the committee on claims, submitted the following resolution:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to John Stalker, or order, the sum of sixty-one dollars, out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury.

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. McMahon, obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act to authorise and empower the commissioners of Allegany county, to levy a sum of money on said county, for the purpose of building an addition to the clerks office of said county.

Ordered, that Messrs McMahon, Beall and Devemora, report the same;

Mr. Williams reported a bill, entitled, an act to provide for the building a court house in Worcester county.

Mr. Kershner, reported a bill entitled, an act extending the time for completing the Turnpike Road from Boonsborough, in Washington county, to the Potomac River, and for other purposes.

Mr. Hartan, reported a bill, entitled a supplement to, an act, entitled an act to lay out and open a road in Cecil county, passed at December Session 1832.

And Mr. Roberts, of Frederick, reported a bill, entitled a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate the Woodsborough Savings Institution, passed at December Session, 1832, chapter 109.

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hughes, from the select Committee, made a favorable report upon the petition of John B. Lawson, of Charles County, praying to be refunded a certain sum of money paid by him into the Western Shore Treasury, accompanied with the following resolution,

Resolved, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the Western Shore, pay to John B. Lawson, or his order, the sum of thirty dollars and twenty two cents, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated;

Which was read the first and second time by special order, the report concurred in, and the resolution therein contained, assented to.
