

*Executive*, Resolution authorising the, to cause such of the public laws of the session, &c. to be published in one newspaper in each county, &c. proposed 652; see *Laws—Newspapers*.

Resolution authorising the, to have the enclosure, &c. round the Public Circle completed, and to draw upon the Treasurer therefor, proposee 652-3; proceedings on—resolution amended, assented to, and sent to the senate 696, returned assented to 701.

*Executors, Administrators and Guardians*, enquiry as to prohibiting from selling slaves belonging to estates of deceased persons, to foreigners or agents of foreigners, or to allow those of wards to be removed from the State, without the permission of the Orphans court, &c.—and as to the expediency of authorising Administrators, d. b. non, to sue for and recover from Administrators or Executors of former Administrators or Executors the balance due estate, and for all devastavit committed, proposed 208 and negatived, 209.

*Expiring Laws*, standing committee on named 17.

Bill reported, to continue the laws which would expire with the present session 273; passed and sent to the senate 345; returned with amendments, which are assented to 548.

Petition of John S. Crocket and Cadmus Dashiell, administrators of Matthias Dashiell, for the continuance of an, 115; bill reported 151; considered 164; passed 169; sent to the senate 171; returned passed 293.

*Expunging*, preamble and resolutions proposed relative to a proposition for,—from the Journal of the senate of the United States, certain resolutions thereon recorded, expressing the opinion of the Legislature that such a measure would be a violation of the Constitution, and requesting the Senators and Representatives of this State, to use all constitutional means to prevent the measure 376-7-8; proceeding on 378; further proceedings on 431-2; substitute proposed 432-3; and negatived 433; motion to postpone, negatived 434; amendment proposed and negatived 434-5; point of order *ib.*; Mr. Wharton proposes a substitute, which is negatived 435-6; resolutions assented to 436; sent to the senate 441; returned assented to 527.
