

Justice, bill for the advancement of, reported, passed and sent to the senate 562.

Justices of the Peace, leave for a bill to explain the act of 1834, ch. 206, defining the jurisdiction of 7—see *Magistrates Courts*.

Leave for a bill to make valid the acts of Isaiah Taylor, as a, of Harford county 15; bill reported 42; passed 58; sent to the senate 64; returned passed 158.

Leave for a bill to extend the jurisdiction of, in certain cases 66; bill reported 84; considered * 111; postponed till May 705.

Petition of citizens of Anne Arundel county that the jurisdiction of, may be increased to \$100, &c. 67; unfavorable report, concurred in 76.

Petition of citizens of Kent county, for a law extending the jurisdiction of, to cases of assault and battery 180.

Bill relating to the jurisdiction and powers now vested in the city of Baltimore, received from the senate and referred 261; favorable report 264; considered * 345; various amendments adopted—bill passed and returned to the senate 359, received again with a message and other amendments 695; which are assented to—bill returned 697.

Petition of citizens of Washington county for an act to make valid the proceedings of, in relation to supersedeas 122.

Supplement to the act of 1825, ch 223, to make valid the acts of, relating to supersedeas, reported 265; counter petition from citizens of Washington county 275; bill considered 341; amended and passed 342; sent to the senate 343; returned with amendments, which are assented to 604.

Leave for a supplement to the act of 1834, ch. 296, defining the jurisdiction of, &c. 442; bill reported 466; enacting clause struck out 616.
