

Library, Resolution directing the, to furnish copies of the Index of the laws &c. to the clerk and Orphans' court of Dorchester county, proposed and assented to 231; sent to the senate 242; returned assented to 255.

Resolution directing the, to deliver to the warden of the goal of Baltimore, certain acts of Assembly received from the senate 247; favorable report 314.

Report of the committee on the, accompanying the annual report of the Librarian 314; see *document L*.

Resolution that all persons who have been members of the executive council of the State shall have when at the seat of government the use of the, &c. proposed and assented to 124; sent to the senate ; returned with amendments which are dissented from 209; message proposed, asking a consideration, and negatived 210.

Librarian, Resolution directing the treasurer to pay to the, annually \$200 in addition to his present salary proposed, and assented to 400; sent to the senate 407; returned assented to.

License Laws. enquiry as to repealing so much of the, as prohibits masters, owners, or supercargoes of vessels, from vending without, plank, shingles and timber &c. ordered 400.

Licences, petition of Chas. W. Smith, J. Duke and others, that Coachmakers of other States may be compelled to take, for selling Coaches and &c. in this State 563, bill reported 607.

Petition of citizens of Caroline county, that Coachmakers of other States may be required to obtain for selling Coaches in this State 562, bill relating to Coach and Gig-makers reported 607; postponed till May 705.

Bill to impose a tax upon Theatrical exhibitions, Circuses, travelling Menageries, and public shows, of every description, reported, passed and sent to the senate 588, returned rejected 625.

Light Houses, preamble and resolution instructing our Senators, and requesting our Representatives in Congress to urge the erection of, on Hoopers Island, Sharps Island &c. proposed 41, variously amended and assented to 59, sent to the senate 64, returned assented to 183.
