Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore pay to Capt. James Brantley one hundred pounds for his Expence and the same being the Balance of his General Account to the 5<sup>th</sup> of April.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Captain James Brantley one hundred pounds to purchase Muskets for his Company.

Copy of Letter N<sup>o</sup> 107 was sent to Captains James Kent and William Henry, Virginia, and a copy of N<sup>o</sup> 108 to William Brantley Esq. Treasurer of the Eastern Shore.

Ordered, That Major Kent send to the Council under a Guard of a Commissary Officer and five privates, 10 Barrels of Musquet Gun powder out of the Magazine at Baltimore Town, also all the Spare jackets and Blankets, 100 Cartouch Boxes, & Balls, and four pair of Generals girths, and that he hire a Wagon for that Purpose.

Ordered, That the Commissary of Stores furnish the Council with an account of the quantity of Musquet Gun powder in the Magazine at Baltimore Town and whether there are any arms arrived from the Head of the Bay and how many.

Adjourned till next day 10 o'clock.
