Tuesday 9th April 1740.

Council Met. Present as yesterday. Mr. Hall & Mr. Rumsey attended.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. William Reynolds thirty Shillings for the Hire of his House 6 days.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Annis thirty five Shilling for making a Coffin for, and burying a Sergeant of Captain Adams Company.

Ordered, That the said Treasurer pay to Captain Nathaniel Ranney three hundred and ninety three pounds four Shilling and one penny.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to William Stiver thirty seven pounds ten Shilling for 200 Steel Ramrods.

Copy of Letter N^o 110. was sent to Mr. William Lux of Batavia Town, copy of N^o 111. to the Committee of Safety of Virginia; and copy of N^o 112. to the Deputies of Maryland in Congress.
