Met according to adjournment. Present the same members as on yesterday.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac Vanbiller one hundred and eight pounds, for Demurrage of Brig Hannah.

M^r Isaac Vanbiller delivered to the Council of Safety, an acct. of 500^{lb} Gun Powder sold in N^o Carolina, which was imported for the use of this Province Am^t. to £ 200. 0^d. 130. 9. 0^d. of which the Council of Safety received from said Vanbiller, and ordered the same to be lodged in the hands of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, which the Clerk did accordingly.

M^r Smyth having first withdrawn, the Council of Safety agreed to allow him & M^r Galloway and Gleward, eight pence Currency p^r Pound for all the Iron, which they shall furnish, and use in building the Gondolas contracted for, on Behalf of this Province.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Weedon four Pounds, twelve Shillings & three pence Currency, for supplying seven Battalion on the Otter Alarm with provisions.

Ordered, that said Treasurer pay to Joseph Merriken nine pounds twelve Shilling for supplying seven Battalion with Subsistence on the Otter Alarm.

Ordered that said Treasurer pay to Isaac Harris one hundred and twenty four Pounds, for his own & Hands services as Attendants to the First Battalion.

Ordered, that said Treasurer pay to Isaac Harris, twenty pounds C^y. for the purchase of Brass-Mounting at Philadelphia.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Powell eighteen Pounds Currency, for his services, as Adjutant to 30th Battalion of Militia.

It was agreed by the Council of Safety, with M^r Walter Hanson of Charles County, that he shall have all the Salt Petre and Sulpher in proportion, belonging to the public sufficient to keep his powder Mill employed, if they can be able to furnish him with that quantity.
