

Remove from thence the whole of the stock except such part thereof as are used for the purpose of tillage.

That the Proprietors of St. John's, St. Charles, St. Anne and St. James Islands, and also of the Islands from Martin to St. John's straightly remove from thence all the stock except such part thereof as are used for the purpose of tillage.

Adjourned till Monday Morning 12 o'clock.

Monday 15 July 1776

Council met. Present the same Members as on Saturday.

John Hall Esq. a member of the Council, attended and was judged before the Council by taking the Oath prescribed by the Convention.

Copy of letter #34 was sent to Lieut. Col. Alexander Boscawen a copy of #35 to Capt. James Bull. a copy of #36 to Brigadier General Grant and a copy of #37 to Col. Richard Baines.

The Council contracted with William Sweet of Boston in Town for the making of twelve beamed tents at seven shillings each and single beamed Tent at seven shillings each.

Ordered that the Company of St. John's deliver to William Sweet all the Tents which was delivered into the Magazine in St. John's Parish of West County.

Copy of letter #38 was sent to Capt. John Allen Thomas and a copy of #39 to Col. James Gordon.

Ordered that Mr. John Hammond be permitted to purchase of James Gordon's lot of plants, and that the same, if it be the case, be taken up for the use of the Province.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles Bland six pounds ten shillings for so much advanced to the said Charles Bland's account against the Province.

That the said Treasurer pay to Charles Bland five pounds on a Bill.

Adjourned till 3 o'clock & met accordingly.

Copy of letter #40 was sent to Brigadier General Howe.

Ordered that the Company of St. John's deliver to Capt. Charles Figg for the use of his company 6 Muskets, 30 Gun flints, 20 Cartouch Boxes and a quantity of Ammunition sufficient for his Company.

That the said Company deliver to Edward Thomas 6 Muskets to be repaired.

That the said Company deliver to George Gordon 12 Muskets to be repaired.

Ordered that the Contractors for provisions furnish such of the soldiers of the flying camp with cations as shall be stationed in or march to Nova Scotia.

The Council contracted with Messrs Charles Bingley and Rowland for 500 Hells for the provision on the conditions mentioned in an agreement of the day.

Ordered that Capt. James Orange's company of Militia for the flying camp march immediately to Baltimore Town.

Ordered that the Contractors for provisions supply the said company
