That the Treasurer pay to William Cayton twelve Shillings, the amount of his account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Mr. Patrick Burk thirty four Shillings, the amount of his account.

Ordered, That Major Price continue at Annapolis, till the further order of the Council.

Ordered that warrants issue agreeable to the Recommendation of the Committee of Frederick County, to the following persons to raise and command the two German Companies to be raised there, to wit:-
