Copy of Letter No 18 from Col. John Mearns.

Mr. Robert Craig agreed with the Council
to lead the King's Blanche with Country Powder for
the transportation of Salt agreeable to a Resolution of
Congress. Copy of the Agreement filed.
Agreed this night day.

Thursday 15 Feb. 1776.

Council met. Present the same Members as yesterday
except Mr. Cole.

Committee issued to Abraham Rumrill appointed
Capt. Thomas Bingham Lieutenant, Thomas Mearns
Detachment and will still consist of a Company of
Militia in a new Council Company belonging to the
South River Battalion.

Agreed all Affairs to be decided by Agreement.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
to Messrs. Rumrill and Robert Mearns five hundred
thirty five pounds eight Shillings for Carriage for the
top of the River of the Province, as of Account.

Mr. Robert Mearns engaged with the Council
to supply powder to him the 2nd 2nd yards of Cannon delivered
to Mr. Lee, also the 165 yards delivered for the North
Mount, and the 16 3/4 yards delivered Mr. Hugh
Mearns.
