Copy of Letter No 18 from Gen. John Mearns.

Mr. Robert Craig agreed with the Council
to lead the Brig Blanche with Country Troop for
the transportation of salt agreeable to a Resolution of
Congress. Copy of the Agreement filed.
Adjourned till next Day.

Thursday 15 Feb. 1776.

Council met. Present the same Members as yesterday
except Mr. Cole.

Committee report to Abraham Lincoln appointed
Capt. Thomas Mearns Lieutenant, Thomas Mearns
Adjutant and Will Hill Surge of a Company of
Militia in a new Regiment which belongs to the
South River Battalion.

Adjourned till 3 o'clock next morning to Agreement.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
to Messrs. Mearns and Robert Mearns five hundred &
thirty five pounds eight shillings for wages for the
use of the Prov. of this Province, as of Account.

Mr. Robert Mearns engaged with the Council
to supply bread to the 2^d Regt of Cannon sent
to Mr. Lee, also the 165 yards delivered for the Shop
Mount, and the 16 3/4 yards delivered Mr. Hugh
Honey.
