Council met. Present as yesterday.
Mr. James Hutchings agreed with the Council to
load the Schooner Fanny, James Carmichael Master
with Country Produce for the Importation of which
agreeable to a Resolution of Congress.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Province
pay to Doct. Alexander Sturges four hundred and
thirty eight Pounds three Shillings and two pence for
Medicines purchased of him by the Council of Safety for
the use of the Army of this Province.

Ordered that the said Treasurer pay to Messrs.
Daniel and John McHenry four hundred and twenty three
pounds three Shillings and six pence for 600 2/2 Yards
of Dyabuyts purchased of them for the use of the
Troops of this Province.

Ordered that Messrs. Daniel and John McHenry
deliver to the Council of Safety 600 2/2 Yards of Dyabuyts purchased
of them by the Council of Safety.
