Mr. Gault was ordered to go to Ballinacorney Town to
assist in the necessary Preparations there.

Ordered that Capt. Reginald Beall's independent
Company be stationed one half of them at Port Tobacco in Charles
County, and the other half at Queen's Point in Calvert County
and that they march to their several Stations as soon as possible.
Copy of Letter No. 37 was sent to the Committee of Observation
for Calvert County.

St. Michael Wallin was appointed first Surgeon, under
the Battalion.

Commission issued to William Boyer appointed third Lieutenant
of Capt. James Abbot's independent Company in the Town of Port
Tobacco aforesaid.

Friday 8 March 1776

Council met. Present as yesterday except Mr. Gault.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the
Committee of Observation for Ballinacorney County one thousand Pounds
Sterling on Account of Provision for the Militia now in Ballinacorney
Town.

A Letter was received from the Committee of Observation for
Ballinacorney County, and answered. (No. 38)

Copy of Letter No. 39 was sent to Brigadier General Grant
and a Copy of No. 40, to Captain James Abbot.

Ordered that Major Thomas Price do draw out of the public
Magazines to Colonel Reginald Beall's independent Company of London
1000.
