Ordered, that Captain John Ganby's independent Company of regulars be stationed at Prince Anne in Somerset County.

Ordered, that the Treasurers of the Lottery there pay to Captain Ganby one hundred and fifty Pounds down annual of his Company - Copy of Letter N. 49 was sent to Captain Ganby.

Ordered, that Colonel John Meems be directed to take two Companies of his Battalion well armed into the City of Annapolis and hold the Rest of his Men ready to resist any Blockades, that may be attempted against any Part of the Coast in his Department, by the Sloop of War or either of her Tenders, who are now in the Mouth of the River Annapolis.

Copy of Letter N. 50 was sent to Mr. Corole and the Committee of Observation of Baltimore County.

Ordered that Colonel John Meems be directed to march the Remainder of his Battalion now at London Town and all the Militia in his Department that he can get together, who have not appeared there, and station them at proper Places to guard the Shore, where the Sloop of War or her Tenders are most likely to attempt Landing.
