

Ordered That the Committee of Observation for the County of Dorchester be under a Guard of a commissioned Officer and two hundred of the County of Dorchester and on behalf of the County of Dorchester be received from Capt. Abbott to the Committee of Observation for the County of Dorchester as they shall appoint to receive it. Also the Barrels to the Committee of Observation for the County of Dorchester for the use of the County of Dorchester, and to the Barrels to Mr. Richard Curwin of Cambridge for the use of Dorchester and Dorset Counties.

Ordered That the Committee of Observation for Dorchester County be under a Guard of a commissioned Officer and two hundred of the County of Dorchester and on behalf of the County of Dorchester be received from the Committee of Observation for the County of Dorchester, and also on behalf of the County of Dorchester, or to such person as persons they shall appoint to receive it.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mr. Abbott one hundred and thirty Pounds above Shillings and pence in full for the County of Dorchester.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore pay the sum of one hundred and thirty Pounds above Shillings and pence in full for the County of Dorchester to reimburse the County of Dorchester in receiving and accounting for the same.

Copy of the above was sent to the Committee of Observation for Dorchester County, and a Copy of No. 70 to Mr. Hugh Young of Baltimore Town.
