Council met. Present as yesterday.

Also to Richard Smith appointed Captain, Lewis White 1st, George Morris 2nd, and Thomas Stays Ensign of a Company of Militia in said District of said County.

Also to John Adams appointed Captain, John Boyer 1st, Christian Weaver 2nd, and Thomas Beatty Ensign of a Company of Militia in the Middle District of said County.

Also to Peter Mearns appointed Captain, Adam Sprick 1st, Peter Adams 2nd, and Nicholas White Ensign of a Company of Militia in said District of said County.

Also to William Kitchie appointed Captain of the 33rd Battalion of Militia, Frederick County.

Copy of Letter No. 88 was sent to Mr. Joshua Beale of Prince Georges County.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Middle District pay to Beniah Mayberry twenty three Shillings and pence for Expenses incurred in sounding the Bells of the Town between Greenbays Point and Horn Point.
