

Memorandum of the Proceedings of the Council of the Province of New York, at a special session, held at the City of New York, on the 15th day of August, 1780. Resolved, That Copies thereof be sent to the several Committees of Observation in each County and District in this Province respectively.

Resolved, That the Genl. David Love be appointed Captain to the Battalion of regular Troops raised for the Defense of this Province and the Liberties thereof.

Ordered, That all the small Arms now at Balltown belonging to the Public and not delivered out to the Troops stationed there, be immediately sent by water under a guard to Chester Town for the use of the independent Companies on the Eastern Side of the Bay; and that the Ordnance imported in Capt. Pickett and now at Balltown Town, or on the way thither, be included in this Order.

Ordered, That four hundred and thirty five Cartridges, Boxes, Belts, Bayonet Belts and Rings, one Ton of Gunpowder and four Ton of Lead be sent to Chester Town for the use of the independent Companies on the Eastern Side of the Bay; and that the Powder be taken out of the Public Stock now at Balltown Town and the same sent out of the Quantity imported in Capt. Pickett, and now arrived at Balltown Town, or on the way thither. That the Genl. be requested to assist Captain Love in having the above Order fully executed, and that Capt. Pickett
