Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Capt. Barton Lucas fifty nine Pounds fifteen Shillings being the Balance of his general Account to the S. Instant.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messrs Beniah Mayberry, Combs Garretson and Ben. Waller nine Pounds each for sounding the Depth of the River between Greenbury's Point and Stone Point.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Mr. John Gibson three Pounds five Shillings for Boat hire &c. as per Account.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Capt. John Hooker Stone forty eight Pounds ten Shillings being the Balance of his general Account to the S. Instant.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Major Thomas Price for £39. 3. 9 for Clothing for the Troop.
