An Answer was received from the Governor
by Letter addressed to the Quillman who waits on
him. (viz. Letter Book, next before No 120)

In answer to which Copy of Letter No 120
was sent to his Excellency.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern
Shore deliver to Mr Benjamin Hanwood unassigned Bill
of Credit of this Province to the Amount of £5000.

Privilege was granted to William Jones, of
the Ship Sally, belonging to Mr Robert Cummings
Lieutenant to the Troops, to pass and repass with
Provisions to any Part of this Province.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western
Shore pay to Mr J^r Black and Mr Connell fifty
seven Shillings for a Shilling and a penny for ...
for the Troops.
