Council met. Present as yesterday. Copy of Letter No 119
to the Hon^{ble} Genl. Gage 2. 1776.
Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore
pay to Robert Reynolds thirty two Shillings for two
Days of Wood for the use of the Council of Safety.

An Answer was received from the Governor
by Letter addressed to the Gentleman who waits on
him. (Viz. Letter Book, next before No 120)

An answer to which Copy of Letter No 120
was sent to his Excellency.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Eastern
Shore deliver to Mr. Benjamin Hanwood unassigned Bills
of Credit of this Province to the Amount of £5000.

Summit was granted to William Jones, of
the Schoep Sally, belonging to Mr. Robert Cummings
Lieutenant to the Troops, to pass and repass with
Provisions to any Part of this Province.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western
Shore pay to Mr. J. Black and Mr. Connell fifty
pounds for 2 Shillings and a penny for Cooks
for the Troops.
