Copied, Martinico; and Copy of No 125 to the
Deputies of Maryland in Congress.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western
Shore pay to the Clerk twenty Pounds to pay
Expenses &c. and that he render an Account of
the Expenditure of the same.

Copy of Letter No 126 was sent to Lieutenant
Col. Wain.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western
Shore pay to Lieutenant Benjamin Brooks two
hundred and fifty Pounds on Account of Captain
John Young's Company.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the said Shore
pay to Captain Thomas Wolford one hundred Pounds
Currency.

The Council agree with Jacob Welch of
Frederick County, who is a supplier to the British
cavalry a Fall of four Tons weight for a
Sum not exceeding fifteen Pounds each.

Adjourned till next Day 10 o'clock
Saturday 20 April 1776.

Council met. Present as yesterday.

Resolved that the same be done to Alexander M. Gordon
appointed 1st Lieutenant, John Peter, 2d Lieutenant
and raised into the rank of Captain Thomas Richardson
Company of Militia in the Town District of Frederick
