

The Council request (Major) to be cause any  
papers that may be lodged at Fredericks Town. Belonging  
to the Publick by Henry, York, John Mousels or any  
other Person, to be brought safely to Annapolis by  
the first opportunity.

Ordered That the Comptroller of Stores send  
to the City of Annapolis in a Boat to be procured  
for that Purpose, and half of all the Linens of  
any kind now in the Magazine, and 10 Reams  
of Hartridge Papers: and render an Account of all  
the Stores in said Magazine, particularizing the  
Muskets fit for Service from those which  
are unfit, and the Provincial from the French.

Ordered that Mr. Edward Parker of Cecil  
County send down to the City of Annapolis by  
Mr. Gilbert Middleton all the coarse Linen  
manufactured for the use of the Province.

Adjourned till next Day.
