Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Smyth Esq^r forty Pounds common Money to be lodged in the Hands of the Committee of Observation for Kent County for the Purpose of reimbursing the Expence of the Carriage of Gunpowder from Indian River to Chatham.

Ordered That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Smyth Esq^r forty two Pounds ten Shillings for 10 Muskets purchased by him for the Use of the Province.

Copy of Letter N^o 8 was sent to the Deputies of Maryland in Congress, Copy of N^o 9 to the Committee of Observation for Baltimore County.

Adjourned till Monday 10 o'Clock.
