

Copy of Letter No 12 was sent to

Ordered that the Treasurer of the
Western should pay to Mr. G. G. G. and Walter
Barnes the sum of five hundred Pounds
to enable them to erect a Lighthouse
agreeable to the Resolutions of the Salt
Marsh.

Adjourned till next day to 10 o'clock

Wednesday June 1771.

Met according to adjournment. Present the same
Members as yesterday except Mr. Smith

Ordered that the Treasurer of the
Western should pay to Mr. G. G. G. and Walter
Barnes the sum of five hundred Pounds to be kept
in the hands of the Committee of Observation
for Ballinacorney Marsh, and by them applied
in erecting the Lighthouse there.
