20 PENN (William) founder of Pennsylvania (1644-1718) Indorsement, as follows—"The map by which the Privy Council 1685 settled the bounds between the Lord Baltimore & I, and Maryland & Pennsylvania & Territorys or annexed Countys"—upon the engraved map "Novi Belgii Novæque Angliæ, necnon partis Virginiae tabula multis in locis emendata à Nicolao Joannis Visschero" in the corner of which is the second pictorial View of New York (New Amsterdam); folded and bound in a small folio volume, in crimson morocco extra 1655?-85
"This map is very scarce. In fact I know of no copy in the hands of a private individual"—says Mr. Asher.
