Be it enacted, That all able bodied male inhabitants of the feveral cillricis, who have no families, and are above the age of twenty-one years and under fifty, and are not otherwise rated or affessed, shall be affessed the sum of eleven pounds sive shillings, in lieu of all other taxes, and that the same assessment be collected by the collectors in the several counties in manner above mentioned, and be paid to the several treasurers at the time herein before specified, any law or usage to the contrary netwithstanding.

And, Whereas it is thought ressonable that all vefsels, the property of persons residing in this state, and employed in carrying on foreign trace and commerce,

Be it enacted, That for every such vessel, at the time of her entry with the naval officer, there shalte paid to the faid naval officer where such vessel is entered, the fum of fitteen thill nge for every ton burthen such vessel may be computed to carry, in lieu of all other assessment or rate; and the several naval officers shall be accountable, on oath, to the treasurer of the shore where such entry is made for the money fo received, and shall pay the sime, first ceducting a commission of four per cent. for receiving, to such treasurer, under the penalty of paving twenty per cent. interest for every neglect or retular; and every matter or commander of such vesse, thall, at the time of such entry, be obliged to discover, on oath, the concage of his versel, or fuch vessel shall not be entered by the teveral naval officers, and the bonds given by the naval officers shall be liable for the due performance of the duty according to the directions of this act.
