An ACT to raife the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty three.

OR raising the necessary supplies for the enof F is suing year, Be it enacted, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the rate or assessment of twenty-five shillings current money, shall be, and is hereby laid and imposed; for every hundred pounds worth of property within this state, and in the same proportion for every greater or less ium; and the said rate or assessment shall be divided into two parts, and shall be paid, collected, and levied, in the manner herein after directed.

Provined, That all property belonging to this state, or the United States, or to any church, county, or parish, or to any public or county school ; all provisions, except live nock, necessary for the use and confamption of the person to whom the same shall belong and his family for the year; plantation utenfils; the working tools of mechanics and munufacturers, actually and constantly employed in their respective occupations; ready money; wearing apparel; and also the personal property of any person who hath been or shall be drove from his habitation in either of the southern: states by the enemy, if such person shall have taken the path of allegiance to the state to which he did belong, and shall settle in this state with the approbation of the governor and council; shall and are hereby excepted from any rate or affesiment.

And provided also, That, if any person (who hath taken the oath of fidelity and support to this state, and hath accordingly exerted himself in favour of the freedom and independence thereof) shall be compelled by the enemy to leave his habitation, and be thereby
