

On the 6th of June the King's Grenadiers of the Prussian army celebrated the sixtieth anniversary of the succession of the Emperor of Germany to the command of the regiment. The regiment itself was formed eighty years ago, and its creation thirty years ago, and it has since its creation fought fifty four minor engagements, including battles, and three sieges; having lost during the several years in the battle of Weissenburg in commencing the year 1806 the colors of the regiment, which were captured by the Prussians, and which are now in the hands of the King, on the same day Battalion Commander von Kaisenberg and First Lieutenant von Lutwitz were wounded with these colors in their hands, and died in consequence of the injuries they received. In the short campaign of 1806 the regiment lost 8 officers, 12 non-commissioned officers, and 114 men killed, and 19 officers, 37 non-commissioned officers, and 111 men wounded. For its conspicuous bravery it was saluted by the King on the field of Austerlitz on the 21 of June, when, being drawn up on parade, it was addressed by his Majesty in these words: "I will do honor to the regiment by drawing my sword and saluting it. My thanks you can read in my eyes."

In answer to the question "What is the flag of the Prophet, and why, if the Sultan unfurled it, would the effect be such a terrible influence as it is intimated in 'dispatches'?" the *Inter-Ocean* says: "The Sanjak Sheriff, or flag of the Prophet, is regarded by the Mohammedans as their most sacred relic. Mohammedan writers tell the story in this way: Mohammed, the Prophet, captured the Korish in battle, and out of his turban made his first battle flag. This descended to his successors, and went into the hands of Omar, the real founder of Mohammedanism. It was kept at Damascus, and at Daglad, and was finally deposited at Constantinople, where it had been guarded with the greatest care for three centuries. It is covered with forty-two wrappings of silk, and interior chapel of the seraglio. The bringing forth of this sacred relic would be an appeal to all Mohammedans. Nations friendly to the Sultan advise him not to take such a step, as it would antagonize all Christian nations."

Bill Posey, who had up to that time led a decent life in Limestone county, Texas, three years ago, began the career of an outlaw. Lack of money could not have incited him to such a course, for he was doing well as a herder, and simple love of devilry must have been the cause. He became a horse thief, and his crimes were as numerous as the twenty-five indictments accumulated against him. He recently escaped from a prison to which he had been sentenced for ten years, and a Sheriff's party, hoping to get the reward of \$500 that was offered for him "dead or alive," pursued him into the Indian Territory. He was armed with a rifle and two revolvers when overtaken, but a shot broke his right arm before he could fire. He tried to use a revolver with his left hand, but a bullet in his shoulder completely disabled him. Still he persevered, and, spurring his horse into a run, eventually turned one of his assailants by a violent collision. Then more bullets were fired to his body, and he was killed.

The late Charles F. Briggs was well known, both in the profession and out of it, for his habit of disputing the most common-sense statement. This propensity often gave to his social intercourse with friends the character of a controversy rather than that of a conversation. Upon one occasion two of his intimate acquaintances, who were seated in the cabin of a Brooklyn ferry boat, saw Mr. Briggs approaching, and immediately bethought themselves of some proposition, the truth of which he could not dispute. Accordingly, when he had taken a seat at their side, one of them, after exchanging a few remarks with him, abruptly said: "Charles, I want to bet you that two and two make four." "Nothing of the sort," promptly rejoined Mr. Briggs; "2 and 2 make 22."

The Economist places the loss in men during the various wars from 1852 to 1877 at 1,918,000, of whom 750,000 died during that of the Crimea; 45,000 in that of Italy in 1859; Schleswig-Holstein, 3,000; United States civil war, 800,000; war of Prussia against Austria, and Italy in 1866, 45,000; Mexico, Cochinchina, Morocco and Paraguay expeditions, 65,000; Franco-Prussian war of 1870-71, 215,000; of whom 159,000 were French and 60,000 Germans; and loss by massacres of Christians in Bulgaria and Armenia during 1876-77, 25,000.

The Dublin Metropolitan Police, in the year ending Dec. 31, 1874, consisted of 2 commissioners, 7 superintendents, 29 inspectors, 149 sergeants, 911 constables, and 42 detectives, total, 1,160. The cost of the commissioners, their superior officers, clerks, &c., was \$12,250; of the police force, \$625,000. The same number of men would in New York, at the lowest salary paid to patrolmen, have cost \$1,400,000. The pay of patrolmen in Dublin begins at \$1.50 a week; the cost of living here is about half that of New York. The Dublin police are magnificent, and a body of men as can be found in the world.

At Monaco recently an Englishman named Walker lost \$15,000—the last of his money—by gambling, and next day he flung himself headlong from a steep rock and was almost instantly killed. His wife and only child were staying at the time with friends in Munich. Walker's total losses amounted to \$75,000. He had amassed a considerable fortune in the cutlery trade at Sheffield, England, and squandered it at gaming tables in various parts of the continent.

A Meritine and Piscatorial exhibition has lately been held at the Aquarium, Westminster, England. It is significant of the interest felt in the subject that at the present time there are no fewer than eighty angling clubs in London and its suburbs, the members of which, to a great extent belonging to the working classes, number about 5,000.
