**HOWARD COUNTY LOCAL LAW.**  
 CHAPTER 281.  
 AN ACT to repeal sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven and ninety-eight of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, and to amend the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, and to add new sections to said Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, to be designated as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety-eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F and ninety-eight G.  
 SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Maryland, That sections ninety-four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven, and ninety-eight of Article fourteen of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that new sections to come in after section ninety-eight of said Article fourteen be added thereto, to be known as sections ninety-eight A, ninety-eight B, ninety-eight C, ninety-eight D, ninety-eight E, ninety-eight F, and ninety-eight G.  
 SECTION 2. No person after the first day of May, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, shall sell, barter, offer for sale, barter or keep for sale or barter in that part of the Second election district of Howard County, included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, any spirituous or fermented liquors or larger beer except as hereinafter provided.  
 SECTION 3. Any person desiring to obtain a license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or larger beer in that part of the Second election district of Howard County included within the corporate limits of Ellicott City, shall file an application in writing with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Howard County, in which he shall state: first his or her name and that he or she is a resident of the Second election district of Howard County; second, that he or she is a citizen of the United States, and has been for twelve months next preceding the filing of such application, a bona fide resident of the State of Maryland; third, that the applicant is not, or if the application is by a firm, that none of the applicants are in any manner pecuniarily interested in the business of a salaried agent, or in any other place where the business is to be conducted under the license sought, specifying the same by definite designation and description; which said application, a bona fide license to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or larger beer in that part of the Second election district of Howard County, shall be issued in favor of the applicant, if he or she or they shall be found to be a suitable person to whom such a license should be issued.  
 SECTION 4. There shall be annexed to said application a certificate signed by at least five reputable freeholders, bona fide residents of the part of the Second election district of Howard County, affected by the sub-title in which the persons certifying shall state that they recommend the applicant as a suitable person to whom such a license should be issued.  
 SECTION 5. Upon said application and certificate being filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County, the said Clerk shall issue a writ of Habeas Corpus for a period not longer than twelve months upon receiving from said applicant the following sum or license fee, viz: If the license is for one month and to sell spirituous and fermented liquors and larger beer the sum of three hundred dollars; if issued for a shorter period, the licensee shall pay for every month, or fractional part thereof, in advance, one-twelfth of the annual charge for such license, and all such licenses shall expire on the first day of May succeeding the day on which they are issued.  
 SECTION 6. The whole of the money received by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Howard County for the license under this Act, shall be paid over quarterly by said Clerk to the State as other license moneys are paid as now provided by law, and when so paid over the Comptroller of the Treasury shall draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State in favor of the Mayor and City Council of Ellicott City for three-fourths thereof, to be applied to the general use of said city.  
 SECTION 7. Every person receiving a license under this Act, shall frame his or her license under a glass and place the same so that it shall at all times be conspicuous and easily read in his or her chief place of making his or her sales, and no license issued under this sub-title shall authorize sales by any person who shall neglect this requirement.  
 SECTION 8. Any person or persons or company having a license under the provisions of this sub-title who shall hereafter be convicted of violating any of the provisions of this Act, or the conditions of his, her, or their license, shall be subject to a fine of not less than one hundred nor more than six hundred dollars; and for any second offense whereof he, she, or they shall be convicted, his, her, or their license shall be vacated and revoked, and he, she, or they shall be subjected to a fine of not less than five hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, or to imprisonment in the jail of Howard County, or in the House of Correction for not less than three months nor more than twelve months, or to both fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. The license of any person or company who permits minors to frequent or loiter about his, her or their place, or disreputable or disorderly persons to make it a customary place of visitation, or resort, may be at any time, upon proof, revoked by the Circuit Court for Howard County, or by the Mayor, Council and City Council of Ellicott City, the same persons shall not again be licensed within two years of the time of said revocation.  
 SECTION 9. And it is enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
