You Would Call Most of the Inventions Absurdities, and Yet They Are Useful—Devices For Poisoning Pests—Traps of Many Kinds.

American invention has given birth to no out of freaks, which have been embraced at the patent office in order that they may not perish.

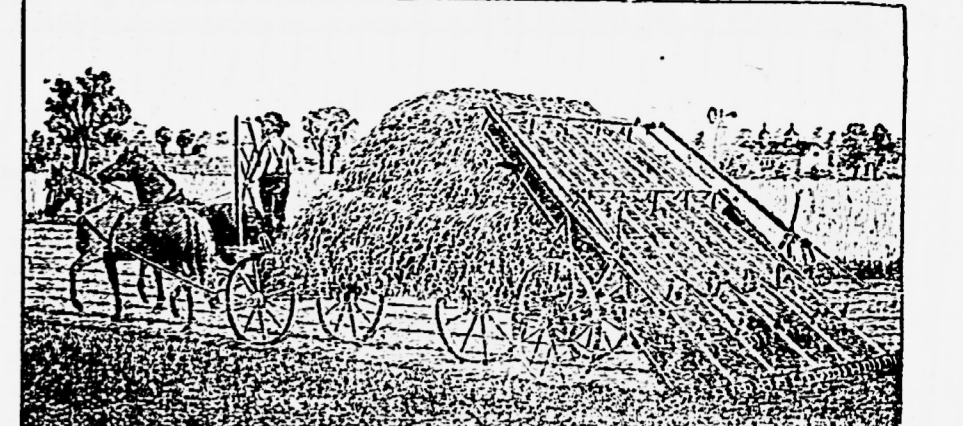
