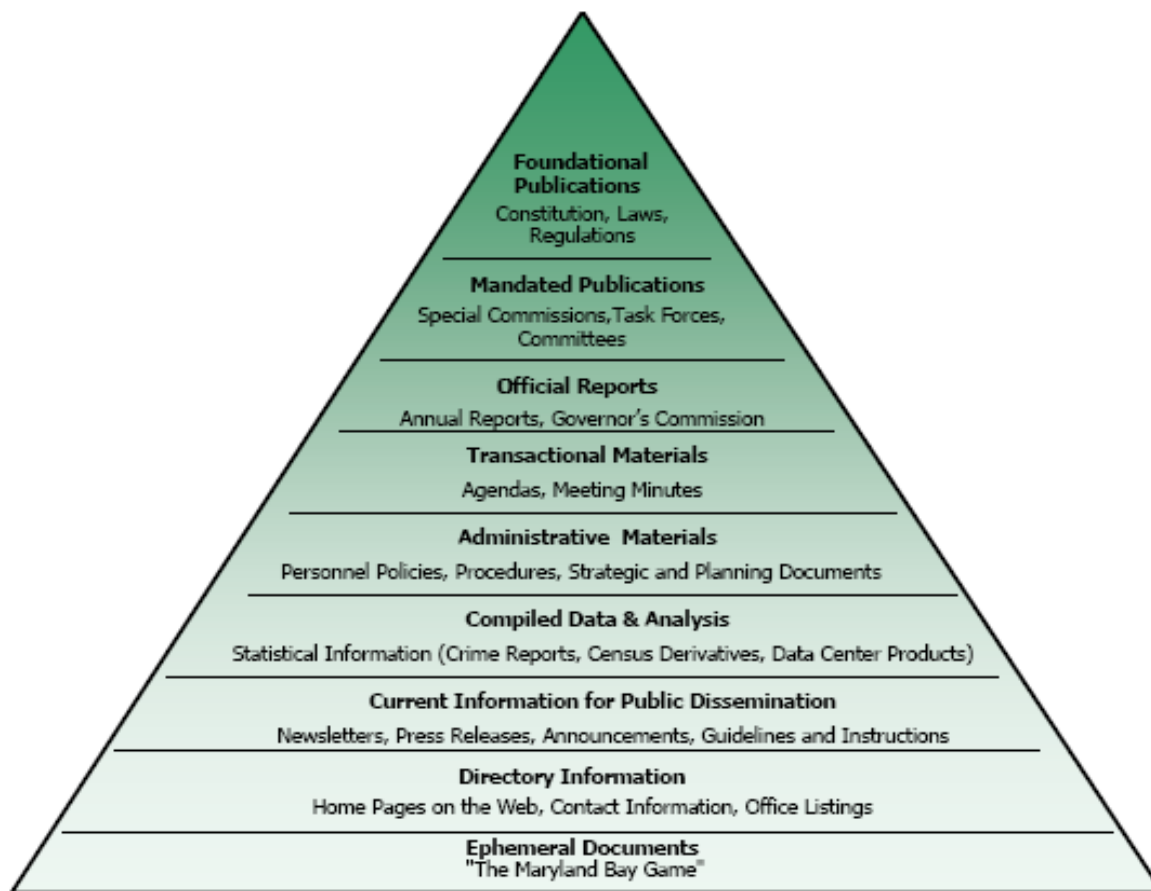

What is a Publication?

One significant category of government records is publications. Maryland regulations define a publication as any informational material developed by or for an agency for the purpose of disseminating that information to the general public (COMAR 14.18.02). To help you identify your agency's publications, here is a chart listing common types of publications with the most valuable publications listed at the top of the pyramid.
