

At the request of Rachel Robertson the following deed was recorded the 20th day of October 1818. to wit: This Indenture made this twenty second day of June, one thousand eight hundred and eighteen between Margaret Brooke of all Montgomery County & State of Maryland of the one part and Rachel Robertson of the County & State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Margaret Brooke for and in consideration of the sum of sixteen hundred dollars to her in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the doct^r hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened, enfeoffed & confirmed and by these doct^r grant bargain sell alien release enfeoff and confirm unto her the said Rachel Robertson her heirs and assigns for ever all those Lots or portions of ground situate and being in the Town of Brookeville in the County aforesaid distinguished in the general plat of said Town as surveyed by Richard Thomas as Lots n^o fourteen and fifteen. To have and to hold said Lots with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or in any manner appertaining and she the Margaret Brooke doth hereby for herself her heirs executors and administrators covenant and grant to and with the said Rachel Robertson that she the said Margaret Brooke, the said Lots or portions of ground hereby granted with all and singular the rights, manors and appurtenances therunto appertaining, unto the said Rachel Robertson her heirs and assigns for ever against her the said Margaret Brooke and her heirs and assigns and against all manner of persons claiming the same by through or under her or her heirs with warrant and for ever defend by their presents.
