Witnesseth that the said Caleb Bently for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and ninety five dollars, money of the United States to him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge, hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien release, enfeoff and confirm unto him the said George Thompson his heirs and assigns for ever all that lot a portion of ground, situate and being in the Town of Brookville, in the County aforesaid distinguished on the general plot of said Town as surveyed by Richard Thomas by lot number forty seven; To have and to hold the said lot with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever, to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining and he the said Caleb Bently doth hereby for himself his heirs, executors and Administrators covenant and grant to and with the said George Thompson that he the said Caleb Bently the said lot or portion of ground hereby granted with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said George Thompson his heirs and assigns for ever against him the said Caleb Bently and his heirs and against all manner of persons whatsoever claiming the same by through or under him or his heirs, will warrant and defend
